The nurseries listed are able to supply appropriate plants from local sources. Greening Australia has relied upon information provided by the individual nurseries to determine their inclusion on this list.

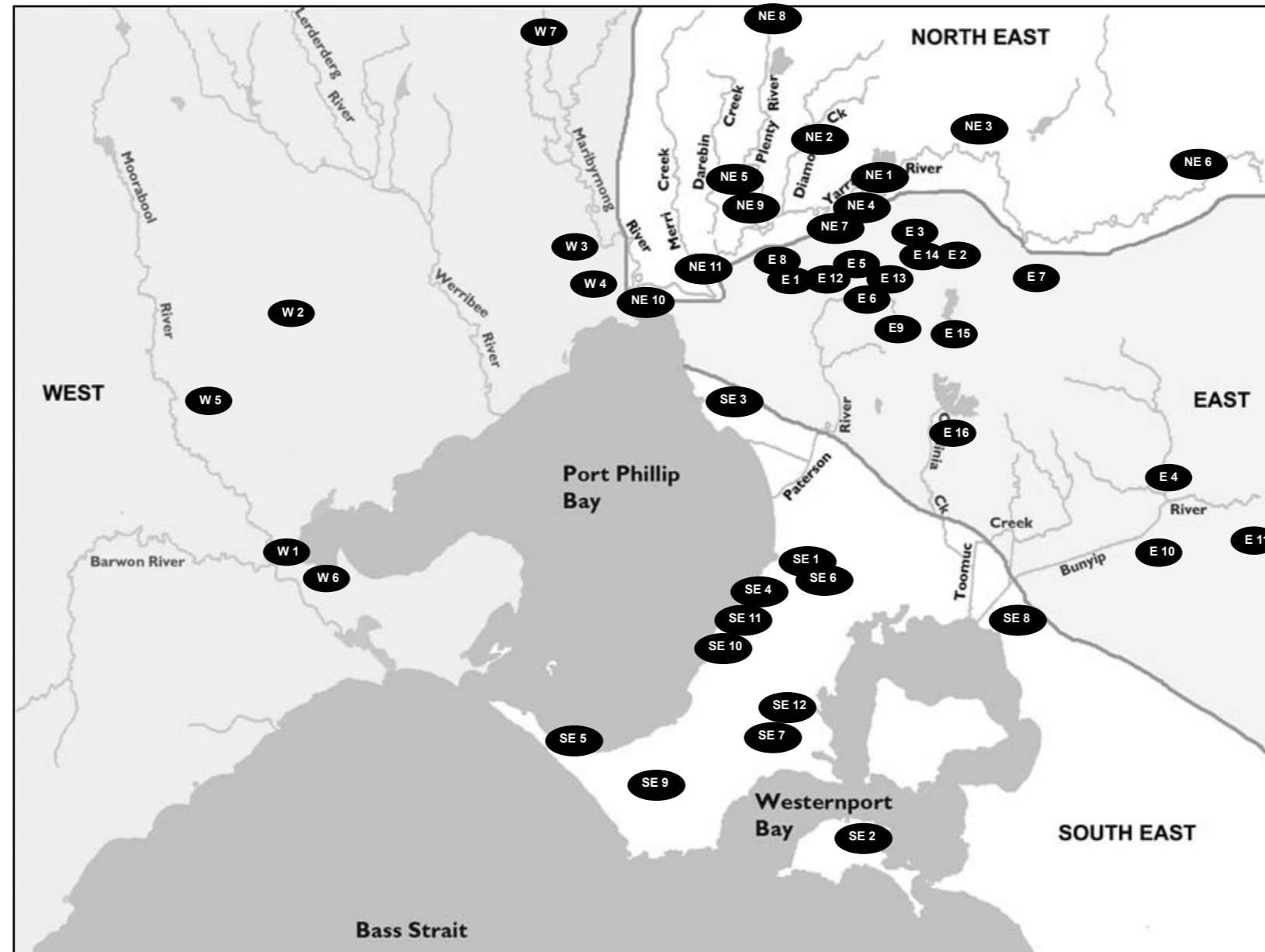
The list has been prepared based on the information provided by the nurseries and Greening Australia cannot accept responsibility for the conduct of any nursery listed.

The adaptations of these plants over many thousands of years to local conditions (such as soils and climate) means that, with good site preparation, they are likely to grow successfully and provide multiple benefits. These adaptations include co-evolution with our native fauna eg. providing food, nest sites, shelter, and our plants depend on native fauna, eg pollinators.

When purchasing stock, ask the suppliers for details of the plant source and the suitability of the plants for your needs.

Please phone before visiting any plant nurseries. This listing will not be current for all nurseries due to the drought in recent years and the closure of some nurseries particularly in northern Victoria because of unreliable water supply issues and increased frost frequency.
